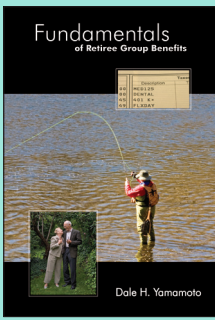

This book attempts to provide a fundamental understanding of almost all of the elements that make up the world of retiree group benefits.

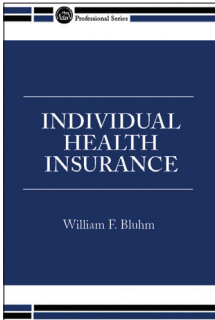

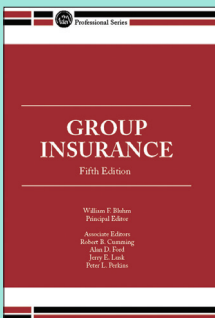

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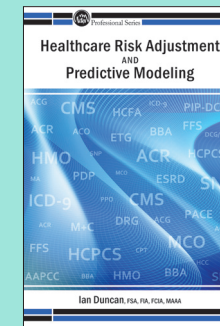
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## Healthcare Risk Adjustment and Predictive Modeling

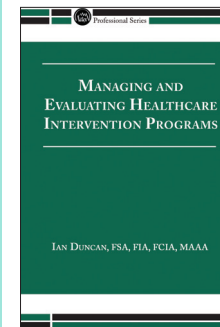

Addressing a new and promising role for healthcare actuaries, it promises to become essential reading for those healthcare professionals interested in driving Return on their Investment in care management programs.

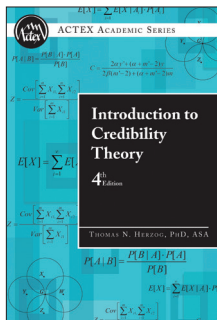

This text presents a wide variety of credibility models in an easy-to-read style and, in so doing, traces the historical development of the subject. The Bayesian approach to credibility is emphasized.

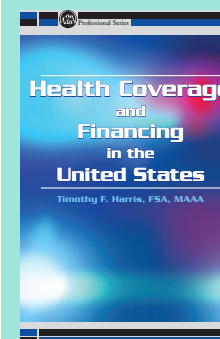
